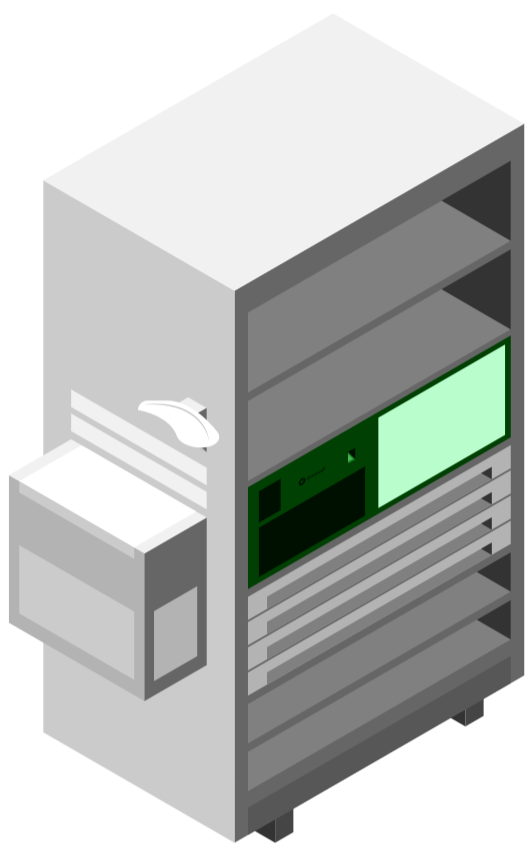


## Control Spend and Minimize Waste

US pharmacies and hospitals waste about \$800 million of expired drugs per year. (Healthline, 2017)

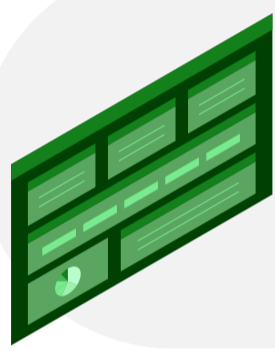


Automated Dispensing Cabinets hold a significant amount of medication inventory data:

**16%** of inventory stocked above par levels or stocked over max.

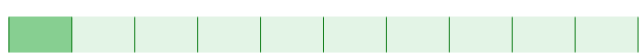
**20%** of medications at risk of expiring without dead stock optimization.

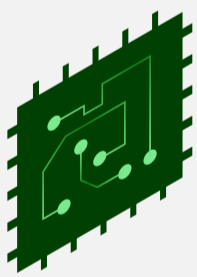

**1 in 10** healthcare providers are abusing drugs.

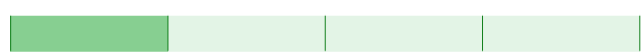
**53%** of hospitals experienced a diversion event in the past year. (Kit Check, 2021)

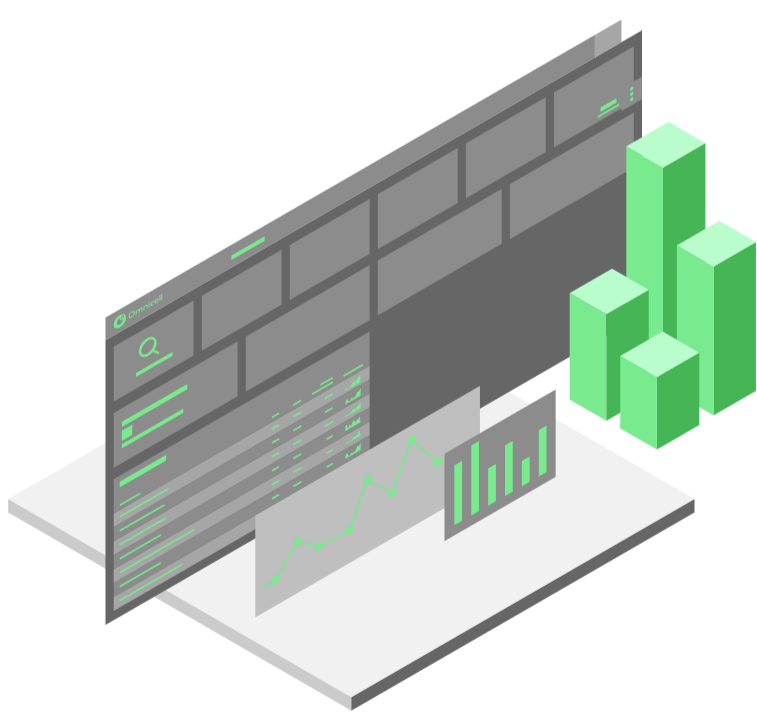
